Blast Auxiliary Premium Air Cleaner

The Blast Auxiliary Premium Air Cleaner is a portable air purifier that is suitable for home, office, and car use. It uses a combination of long-lasting HEPA filters, an activated charcoal filter, and anion technology to remove pollutants like dust, smoke, and bacteria from the air.

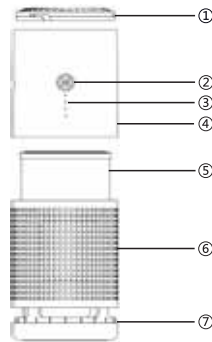

- ① Air quality indicator
- ② Function button
- ③ Fan/Ionizer Indicator Lights
- ④ Main fan unit
- ⑤ HEPA Filter
- ⑥ Air intake vents
- ⑦ Base to hold HEPA filter

How to Use Your Air Cleaner

1. Connect the Type-C cable to the Premium Air Cleaner.
2. Tap the function button once to put the Premium Air Cleaner fan in automatic mode. Tap the function button repeatedly to go through the three different fan speeds.
3. Once you've reached High speed, press the function button again to switch the Premium Air Cleaner off.

How to Use the Negative Ionizer

1. Press and hold the function button to enable anion (negative ionizer) mode. A white indicator light will blink once the mode is switched on.
2. Press and hold the function button again to disable anion mode.

Note: The anion mode can be enabled/disabled from any fan speed.

Quick Use Guide

Action	Mode
One tap	Switched on / Automatic mode
Two taps	Fan speed 1
Three taps	Fan speed 2
Four taps	Fan speed 3
Five taps	Switched off
Press and hold	Enable/disable anion mode

How to Read the Air Quality Indicator

- Red** - Dirty air
- Blue** - Average-quality air
- Green** - Clean, filtered air

Note: When the Premium Air Cleaner is switched on, the red, green, and blue indicators will all light up. You'll then see the green indicator light for around 3 minutes. Then, the Premium Air Cleaner will switch colors depending on the air quality in the room.

How to Change the Filter



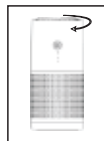
Turn the fan cover counterclockwise to open the device.



Take out the HEPA filter.



Replace with a new filter.



Reattach the fan cover and turn it clockwise to tighten.

Note: Use only the official Blast Auxiliary Premium Air Cleaner Filter available via blastauxiliary.com.

Safety Reminders

- Clean the filter every 2 weeks, and replace it with a new Blast Auxiliary Premium Air Cleaner Filter every 3 months.
- When cleaning the filter element, do NOT wash it with water. Instead, use a hairdryer to blow on the inside of the filter element, or use a soft brush (such as a toothbrush) to clean the dust on the surface of the filter. Take care not to damage the filter element.
- Do NOT spray corrosive liquids such as essential oils, perfumes, and colognes on the filter.
- The Blast Auxiliary Premium Air Cleaner is designed for areas of 5 to 10 square meters.
